

Study of Cholesterol Lowering Drug HPS-4/TIMI 65/ORION-4

If you are 55 years or older and have suffered from a heart attack, stroke or peripheral arterial disease (PAD), you may be eligible to participate in a research study.

Currently conducting a study for a new drug to lower bad (LDL) cholesterol which is given by injection about twice a year.

We are studying an experimental drug that has been shown to reduce LDL cholesterol, even if you are already on statin therapy. If you are eligible and agree to participate, you will receive study drug or placebo. *(Placebo is an inert substance or treatment which is not designed to have a therapeutic value.)*

There will be no change to your current medications

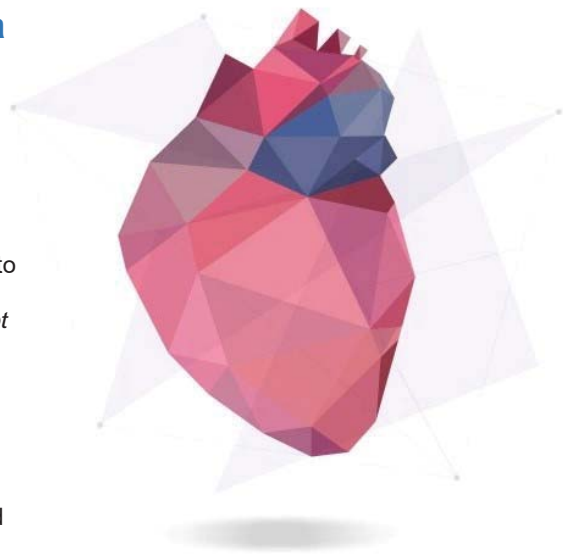
Timeline

- 3 in-person visits in the first 5 months and then every 6 months for about 5 years

Are you eligible?

Aged 55 or older and have suffered from one (or more) of the following:

1. Prior heart attack
2. Prior stroke
3. Peripheral arterial disease (PAD) with lower extremity revascularization or aortic aneurysm repair
