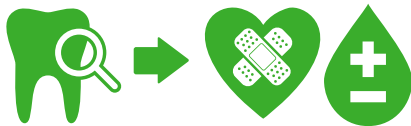


Healthy mouth Healthy body

- The lifetime cost of a cavity can total more than \$2,000
- Fluoride treatments and sealants are available for children to help prevent cavities, which can be costly to treat.
